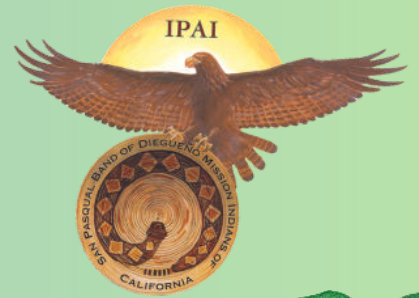

WORKING TOGETHER FOR HEALTHIER TRIBAL WORKSITES

The San Pasqual Anti Tobacco Project is working on an important initiative to help keep our community healthier and safer. We are working on adopting a 25 foot smoke free worksite entry policy. This policy will help protect everyone who visits or works in Tribal buildings.

This new policy means that people will not be allowed to smoke within 25 feet of the entrances to any Tribal Government worksite. In the future (unless culturally based), our vision is to grow this rule so that no one smokes near any Tribal building at all. This initiative does not include casinos.

Which buildings are included?

All Tribal Government worksite buildings such as: Fire Department, Education, Environmental, Water, Planning, Roads Maintenance, Housing, Tribal Government Building, including Human Resources, Finance, Information Technology, and the Business Committee

We want everyone who works in these buildings or visits them to breathe clean, healthy air.

Why is this important?

Breathing clean air helps everyone stay healthy. Smoke can travel through the air and affect people standing nearby, even if they are not smoking. By keeping smoke away from building entrances, we make sure that families, elders, youth, and staff can walk in and out of buildings safely.

Our Vision for the Future

The San Pasqual Tribe wants to create a cleaner and healthier environment for everyone. This 25 foot smoke free worksite entry policy is an important first step. Together, we can help keep our Tribal lands safe, strong, and healthy for all families today and for future generations.
